3. Now it's time to create your own how-to tutorial:
 - a. What is the product or task that you are going to be demonstrating?
 - b. Who is your audience?
 - c. Create a storyboard, or a plan, for what your tutorial will look like.
 - d. Create a script
 - e. Practice, practice, edit, practice.
 - f. Feedback- have a grown-up look at your storyboard, and script, and see if they have any ideas on how to make it even better.
 - g. Record your tutorial/how to video.
