

Auxilium Education Coaching presents: Ideal Vacation Monday, March 16, 2020

Since we're all cooped up, this is a great daydream sort of activity

<u>Supplies</u>- notebook for taking notes, pencil or pen, colored pencils or markers, 8.5x11 piece of paper (*optional:* printing capability for pictures, scissors, and glue)

- 1. Have each child look at a map- or talk about where they would love to visit or have a dream vacation
 - a. https://www.kids-world-travel-guide.com -this site is super kiddo friendly and has a lot of information as a jumping off point
 - b. discuss what some good research sites might be
 - c. Kids who are not able to write, yet, can draw pictures as "notes"
- 2. Locate the place on a map and/or globe
- 3. Help your student/s list some facts about the location
 - a. Region of the globe
 - b. Climate
 - c. Population
 - d. Language(s) spoken
 - e. Points of interest- geographic, natural, cultural, historical
 - f. Types of products grown there
 - g. Typical food to that region
- 4. After they have completed their research, have them talk with you about why they would like to visit- or write a persuasive paragraph as to why this is their ideal vacation.
- 5. Compile all of their research- to create a travel pamphlet on their ideal vacation. See the following website for a visual example. https://cdn.quotesgram.com/img/74/13/887844666-713baa55609ebca636f8b0d85abc9f7c.jpg
 - a. Take an 8.5x11 piece of paper and fold in into three even sections.
 - b. Have them create an eye-catching cover that will have people want to grab their pamphlet off a rack.
 - c. Each fold in the paper should be a different topic- each section should have some writing and an illustration or two- depending on the academic level of the child. Here are the items that should be included in the pamphlet. (This can be done on a computer or by hand- whichever your student decides)
 - i. Cover
 - ii. History
 - iii. Places of interest
 - iv. Population- including languages spoken, traditional practices, religion, interesting facts about the region
 - v. Food items
 - vi. Sample trip itinerary on the last section: possible hotels, sites to visit, restaurants to eat at, possible souvenirs to purchase

Activity continuation:

- 1. Watch National Geographic on Disney+ about the region of the world their chosen location is in.
- 2. Instead of a pamphlet, create an essay about their ideal vacation
- 3. Create an art piece that reflects their ideal vacation
- 4. Go online and find books about their ideal vacation location and find one or two to purchase
