Israel

Eretz Hakodesh, Land of Holiness, comprises two dances in an expression of love for Israel. Israeli dance is young, spirited and vital. It weaves a colorful tapestry of a diverse people in an ancient land.

Puerto Rico

Plena Boricua vibrates to the Caribbean sounds of African drums as the islanders party in the cabanas or on the warm, sandy beaches.

Reuel Zielke Scotland

Caledonian Salute is composed of the Scottish Lilt, a National dance, and Troy's Wedding, a lively jig tempo conveying the joyous spirit of Scottish weddings, followed by a traditional Highland dance, Dannsa na Gaidhealtachd, performed to a blend of Scottish instruments with an aboriginal didgeridoo. Soloist: James J. Frazee

Katerina Tomás Spain Fiesta Flamenca showcases the liveliest versions of Spanish flamenco: Gitano, Soleares, and Alegrias.

The palmas (hand claps), and canto (singing) culminate in a fin de fiesta, the Bulerías.

Way Down Yonder, a medley of traditional songs and tunes: Back up and Push, Leather Britches, and Pia in a Pen. Delynne Peay

Texas Fandango is a humorous characterization of the American Cowboy showing him at his dancin' best-kickin' up a little dust.

Pioneer Heritage Medley portrays the strength of the Mormon Pioneers. Singing and dancing often revived tired spirits and warmed bodies after a long day's cold journey.

Delynne Peay Poland

Polonez, one of Poland's most well-known dances, was traditionally performed at the commencement of every large gathering and celebration. Followed by Kujawiak and Oberek, these dances combine to reflect the rich dance tradition of Poland.

Korea

Magyar Csizmadia is a legényes (lads dance), a gathering of men improvising and competing with steps and movements from the region of Kalotaszeg.

Dunamenti Táncok, (Dances of the Danube) features the rhythms and steps of Kalocsa. A traditional Mars moves the party from place to place before unfolding into a lassu (slow) and then a friss (fast) Csárdás.

István Zoltán Szabó

*Pásztor Botoló*, commonly known as a "herdsman's dance," demonstrates the shepherds' skill and virtuosity in handling their stalves. Anciently, the staff was used to protect the flock from dangerous predators.

Halyna Shawl is a lyrical expression of Ukrainian women. The exquisite shawls accentuate the graceful movements.

*Poltavskyi Hopak*, the national dance of Ukraine, was historically performed by men during the famous Cossack period. Today this Ukrainian hallmark includes women. Our version begins with the traditional *Offering of Bread and Salt*, where special guests are welcomed and honored in a meaningful way.
