Family Forward is a free comprehensive program designed to address a critical gap in services within our community by extending wrap-around, stabilizing services and certified peer support to families impacted by substance use.

Safe Baby Court is a specialized court program for families of infants and toddlers, up to 3 years old. This program works collaboratively with the Juvenile Court, DCS, and a team of professionals to assist parents along their journey to reunification by connecting them to peer services, resources, education, etc. through monthly team meetings and court hearings.
