

Friends of Sagamore Hill • 2013 Gable Lecture Series

This spring, the Friends of Sagamore Hill will sponsor the Ninth Annual Dr. John A. Gable Lecture Series, held in Christ Church Parish Hall, 61 East Main Street, in Oyster Bay. The three-lecture series honors the legacy of Dr. Gable, who as long-time Director of the Theodore Roosevelt Association served as a tireless advocate of both Theodore Roosevelt and his enduring presence on the American scene.

The series opens on Thursday, March 21, with **Roger L. Di Silvestro**, naturalist and editor and, most recently, author of *Theodore Roosevelt in the Badlands: A Young Politician's Quest for Recovery in the American West*. The series continues on Thursday, April 18, when **Chip Bishop** visits Oyster Bay to discuss his latest book *The Lion and the Journalist*, portraying the friendship of Theodore Roosevelt and his biographer Joseph Bucklin Bishop. The concluding lecture, on Thursday, May 16, introduces photographer **Xiomáro**, who will draw on his experience photographing the interior of the Roosevelt home at Sagamore Hill, after removal of the house's furnishings as part of the site's rehabilitation project.
