- •All Livestock entered may not have been shown at any other County Fair.
- •The Livestock barn will be open to set up pen's on September 13, 2023; 4:00 pm until 7 pm. The Barn will be locked down at 7:00 pm on September 13, 2023, no Exceptions.
- •The exhibitor will be required to display a stall card for each exhibit. Greenlee County will provide the stall cards. The information that will be required on the stall card: name of the exhibitor, breed of animal, weight of animal, and age of animal. This information will be filled out with the exception of Weight on the exhibit entry form. One may also decorate pen and or personalize a sign to hang above pen.

- •All Non-Open Market Small Stock entries must meet the rules of the Small Stock Association and Greenlee County to be eligible to show at the Greenlee County Fair.
- •Greenlee County follows the rules and regulations instituted by the Arizona Department of Agriculture concerning Livestock Health, transportation, and out of State Livestock requirements.
- Exhibitors Entering the Small Stock Association Division must keep and submit an acceptable record book on their animal(s) following record book guidelines for their club organization.
- •All Livestock entered in the Greenlee County Fair may not have been shown at any other County Fair.
- •Exhibitors entering under the Small Stock Association must turn in exhibit entry form and Ag Display to Fairgrounds office by 09/09/2021. Those who meet these requirements will receive a gate entrance to enter to feed animals daily during fair.
- Exhibitors are required to supply breed of animal, and age of animal on Exhibit entry form by September 9, 2021. Information is required for pen tags.
- Greenlee County will provide the initial shavings for pens. Additional shavings will be the exhibitor's responsibility.
- Greenlee County requires all exhibitors to be able to handle and control their animal.
- •It is highly recommended the exhibitor handle, wash and feed their own animals and when needed be assisted by another youth exhibitor or leader.
- All birds will be judged in cages, by comparison and the APA, NPA, ABA Standard of Perfection
- •Greenlee County requires Youth Exhibitors to be dressed according to their club dress code for exhibition and sale.
- Classes will be set by breed standards determined by the superintendents and Judge.
- Pens and allies must be kept clean throughout fair. Final cleaning of pen(s) will be Sunday after animals are released by 2:00 PM or exhibitor will be fined \$25.00, which will be deducted from the exhibitor's sale or premium check.
- Birds showing evidence of a contagious disease or parasite will be disqualified and asked to leave fairgrounds.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for proper security of his/her animal.
- All animals will be fed and watered normally while residing at the fairgrounds. Each exhibitor is required to provide their own feed.

RABBIT EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. **This show is NOT an ARBA Sanctioned Show** ~ *only Greenlee County Residents are eligible to enter.* Rabbits will, however, be judged following the rules and guidelines under ARBA.
- 2. Exhibitor must own and be raising rabbit on or before June 7, 2023. No exceptions.
- 3. Entries must have a legible, clearly defined tattoo ~ in the left ear. This must be done prior to receiving day. No tattooing will be done on the fairgrounds.
- 4. Indicate breed and age of rabbit ~ ex: Division = Breed, Class = Color, Subclass = Age/Sex. Sample- Mini Rex, Blue, Senior Buck = Division 3731, Class 163C. Do not use birth date or indicate age by months and years. If you are uncertain about the age of your animal, contact your leader, advisor, or the Department Superintendent.
- 5. Rabbits with evidence of parasites or contagious disease will be disqualified and returned to owner for removal from building or quarantined. Unruly, mean and biting animals will not be accepted.
- 6. Breeding animals at the fairgrounds is prohibited. A doe that has babies at the fair will forfeit wins.
- 7. Waterers & feeders must be furnished by the exhibitor. NO GLASS. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding their animals throughout the fair. Morning feedings must be done by 10 am and evening feedings must be done by 8:00 pm.
- 8. Greenlee County is not responsible for any loss or damage to animals, equipment, etc. that might occur. Entries are made and accepted on this condition.
- 9. The fair is not responsible for animals left after specified release times.
- Rabbits cannot be removed from cages without permission from the Department Superintendent. Notify Superintendent for showmanship
- 11. Exhibitors do not place anything in rabbit cages without permission from the Superintendent. Violation can result in disqualification.
- 12. Do Not attach "for sale" cards to cages. If you are found to be attempting to sell an animal outside of the auction, you will be disqualified, forfeit all prizes and auction monies.
- 13. Exhibits for fryer, baker, and roaster will be entered in regular division.
- 14. Small Stock Association Dress Code required.
- 15. Removal of show animals prior to the end of fair is prohibited. (Only exceptions that will be made are for health reasons by fair officials)
