RIDER RULES

- Watch for steps, curbs and gutters
- Sit promptly after boarding
- Use handrails while walking and standing
- Remain seated until the vehicle has reached its stop
- Safely stow belongings
- All laundry must be stored in a closed bag or bin
- All oxygen supplies and bottles must be properly stored
- Refrain from traveling with oversized belongings
- Supervise children
- All children under the age of 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult
- Fold and store strollers
- Use headphones while listening to music or other media
- Follow the appropriate dress code
- Refrain from tobacco and alcohol usage
- No eating unless medically necessary
- No defaming property
- No explicit language or controversial commentary allowed
- No traveling with hazardous materials, explosives or weapons
- No distribution of print materials
- Always pick up after yourself
- Only service animals and pets in carriers are permitted
- Refrain from distracting the driver

LOST & FOUND

- Report all missing items by calling 254.933.3700
- All missing items are turned into the dispatcher on duty and logged into our system for safety purposes
- Proper identification and in-person pickup of found items is required
- All found items will be kept for a minimum of 30 days and securely stored
- Unclaimed items, after the 30-day hold, will be donated to the nearest Salvation Army or Goodwill

WHERE DOES THE HOP OPERATE?

The HOP operates Microtransit and complementary Regional Commuter services in the Killeen-Copperas Cove-Harker Heights and the Temple-Belton urban area, and Microtransit and Demand-Response service in rural communities within the four-county transit district. WHO CAN USE THE HOP?

Everyone is welcome on The HOP. Riders under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Our fleet also includes wheelchair accessible vehicles.

HOW DO I UTILIZE SERVICES?

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Trip cost ranges from \$2-\$4 depending on the service and distance. Qualified riders receive half fare with proof of eligibility. For a complete fare table, visit
