


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INTRODUCTION

Substance Use Coaching

Nuturing Father Group


Led by our founder, Garrick Thames, this program addresses the unique challenges fathers face today. Through weekly sessions, we provide a space for discussion, learning, and growth, focusing on the importance of active, engaged fatherhood.

Outreach and Community Engagement



Through a variety of channels including social media, community events, and partnerships, we actively reach out to those in need. Our presence in the community ensures that support is accessible and available to all who seek it.

2023 BUDGET ALLOCATION



Outreach Materials (\$500 for Unseen Hands): This investment funded the production of printed T-shirts, business cards, and other promotional materials. These items played a crucial role in enhancing our visibility in the community, facilitating outreach efforts, and fostering a sense of belonging and identity among our members and volunteers.

Child Safety (\$750 for End Child Molestation): We allocated funds towards 60 molestation kits for fathers, emphasizing the importance of child safety within our community. This initiative not only provided essential tools and information to protect children but also engaged fathers in active discussions and education on preventing child molestation.

Program Graduation Support (\$400 for Carol Miranda): Celebrating the achievements of our participants, we dedicated funds to 20 graduation bags. These bags, filled with useful items and resources, were distributed to individuals who successfully completed our programs, marking their progress and encouraging their continued journey toward self-improvement.

Educational Resources (\$717.88 for Lulu): Recognizing the power of education, we invested in books and educational materials to support our learning and development programs. This investment enriched our resource library, providing participants with access to knowledge and tools to aid their personal and professional growth.

Basic Necessities & Support

- Underclothes (\$887.47 for Target): We purchased essential clothing items to ensure that individuals and families we serve have access to basic necessities, promoting dignity and comfort.
- Gift Cards (\$305 for Target): Gift cards were distributed to provide flexible support for food, clothing, and other essential items, empowering recipients to address their immediate needs in a dignified manner.

Winter Clothing Drive (\$352.33 for Primark): With the cold Boston winters in mind, we allocated funds towards purchasing coats for our Toy Giveaway event. This initiative provided warmth and protection for individuals and families during the harsh winter months, embodying our commitment to meeting the holistic needs of our community.

Community Event Catering (\$400 for Joe's Sub Shop): Funding pizzas for our Toy Giveaway created a welcoming and festive atmosphere, fostering community spirit and togetherness. This investment in catering supported a memorable event that brought joy, warmth, and community connection during the holiday season.

Garrick Thames has profoundly impacted the Boston community through his personal journey of recovery and transformation, leading by example to inspire those around him. His organization, "Lives Are Meant to Be Changed," focuses on empowering individuals facing personal challenges, particularly those re-entering the community after incarceration and battling substance abuse.
