




# ATLANTA AIRPORT & TRANSPORTATION

ATLANTA's Hartfield-Jackson International Airport is the busiest airport in the world and has been for the last 23 out of 24 years. Here is <u>an article and some tips</u> for Navigating Atlanta's Airport.



The **Plane Train** is Hartsfield-Jackson's underground automated people mover. It connects the domestic and international terminal buildings with the airport's **seven concourses** (T, A, B, C, D, E & F) and domestic baggage claim.



#### **Ground Transportation Centers**

Located at the **western end of the domestic terminal**. Transportation options from the airport include shuttles, buses, MARTA rail, rental cars, limousines, or taxis.

• Free, 24-hour-a-day shuttles are available from the domestic terminal, parking areas and **Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (MARTA) train service.** MARTA operates a train line that connects the airport to downtown Atlanta. The train ride takes approximately 20 minutes<sup>1</sup>.



- A free shuttle is available to takes passengers to the rental car center. All 12 rental car companies are connected to the airport via the **ATL SkyTrain** from the domestic terminal. The **ATL SkyTrain** also stops at the Georgia International Convention Center.
- **Ride-Sharing Services (<u>Uber</u> and <u>Lyft</u>)** can drop passengers off curbside; temporary pickup locations are well-marked and are located in the economy lots. You can easily request a ride using their apps for door-to-door transportation. Look for **orange signs** if you're heading to rideshare or the cellphone car lot<sup>12</sup>.
- **Taxis** are also available at ATL. You can find them at designated taxi stands for transportation directly to your desired location.

#### OTHER TRANSPORTATION

#### **Atlanta Streetcar**

Operating on rail, Atlanta Streetcar makes 12 stops along a 2.7-mile loop and offers a safe, convenient means of connecting some of Atlanta's most popular sites in the convention and entertainment district, all the way to the Sweet Auburn District. Single trip fare is \$1; multiple trip passes are available.

#### **Last-Mile Mobility**

Options such as Relay Bike and scooters (such as BIRD, Lime, and Uber) are in various areas of the city. Simply download an app, locate the transportation mode, and unlock it from the app.





# **Departing ATL**

Flying out of Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) can be a breeze with some helpful tips. We strongly encourage you to arrive at the airport at least 2 and ½ hours prior to departing Atlanta.

- **Arrival Time:** Aim to arrive at least **2 hours** before your domestic flight departure time. This allows for check-in, security, and any unexpected delays.
- Ground Transportation:
  - **Arriving by Car**: If dropped off or picked up, use the **lower-level entry** on the domestic side near hourly parking for curbside access. Avoid switching lanes on the upper level.
  - **Public Transportation**: Atlanta's **public rail line (MARTA)** has an airport station. Trains run from downtown to the airport and surrounding neighborhoods.
- Navigating the Airport: ATL's automated people mover, the Plane Train, connects concourses. Trips between each of the seven concourse stops average just two minutes.

*Note:* Familiarize yourself with **directional signage**, which may be behind foliage.

• **Security Checkpoints:** Security lines usually take **20 to 30 minutes**. Arrive early and check security wait times online in advance.

Tip: If you have TSA PreCheck, make sure your whole party is in the same airline reservation to go through TSA PreCheck with you.

# • Lounges and Dining:

- ATL has 14 airport lounges. The largest Delta Sky Club is on Concourse B, offering panoramic views of downtown Atlanta.
- With over **100 restaurants**, including homegrown options like Grindhouse Killer Burgers, you will not go hungry.
- For drinks, try Concourse E's One Flew South, a two-time James Beard Award nominee, or sample local breweries at rapper Ludacris's Chicken + Beer on Gate D-5<sup>1</sup>.

#### • Passing the Time:

- Explore the downstairs people-mover near the Plane Train. It features exhibits on Atlanta history, Zimbabwean stone sculptures, and even a faux rainforest with LED lights.
