

Make sure you place the tag gun through a raised lip of INSIDE fabric/edging, near the neck area. Don't go all the way through the back of the fabric to avoid making a hole in the garment.



This picture shows what NOT to do—this WILL leave a hole if you go straight through the fabric.



Do NOT place the tag through an outside seam as consignors frequently miss the seam and cause a hole in the fabric. Also, the arm pit area is NOT the location to place the tag as this area makes it very difficult for us to scan tags and sort items at the end of the sale.



This is how you should safely tag through an inside seam, but make sure you carefully go through the "lip" area on the inside of the shirt and not all the way through the shirt.



Do NOT tag gun an item on a size tag that is located at the bottom of the shirt as this makes it hard for us to find the tag and quickly scan it and makes sorting very slow for us. If there is a size tag in the neck area that is the perfect spot to place the tag.
