Survey Overview

A total of 150 random surveys were sent out to the GPP residents selected from a Registered Voters lists provided with no names associated with the addresses provided under the registered voter tab.

The 12th and the 17th, and the 23rd addresses were selected from each page.

There was a 60% response rate.

Response details are provided. 38 additional resident comments were provided and are attached.

Conclusions

This survey clearly demonstrates the desired use of Trombly as an educational institution.




Serious and proactive initiatives to maintain Trombly as an educational institution should be the top priority of the BOE, GPP Council and Community.


