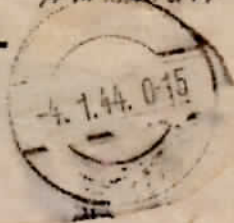

I am whole and well and very well fed and clothed. I am uninjured and hope this letter eases a bit of your consideration on my behalf.

Be sure to assure all my friends of my safety - also hope all of this didn't ruin your Christmas.

I wish you would ask the Red Cross of all information concerning Prisoners of War and propose to send what you can when I send you my permanent address. I will be in my permanent camp in a few days and will advise you of the address as soon as possible.

British and American Red Cross provide us cigarettes and warm clothes in addition to some reading material.

I consider myself lucky, very lucky indeed in being alive and being uninjured is a miracle.

Give all my love and regards to everybody - I will write again with a request for things you can send me - Love Robert
