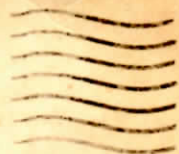

Paul jr, would have been sent to Chicago for a course; if he had not been on sick list, Ellis was sent to Boulder, Colo. from California. They both left on Jan. 3rd. Paul was sent to Idaho, not far from Spokane. Eva Louise spent 2 weeks with us. She was looking fine. your letters came to us, quickly and we were very glad to hear.
