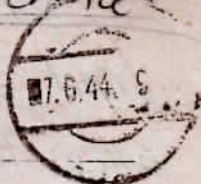

Lately we have had several light snows - It is a different snow than that of home. It seems to be a much dryer flake.

The British officers here are giving us instructions to play soccer and Rugby, and they <sup>play</sup> football with us.

A few of the boys have received mail from the states, but it has been five months since they were captured, on that basis you should receive this letter just about the time I receive your first one to me, I hope.

The last letter I wrote before being shot down was to Christine. The night

before I received a letter from you.

Send Tr. an allowance out of my account about the 15<sup>th</sup> of every month.

I hope everyone is in good health as I am. Love to all of you.
