Dear Robert,

We are rejoicing that you are safe and good health.

Time passes quickly and it is gardening time. I have potatoes, onions, beans, turnips and spinach planted. So hope I will have a nice garden. Of course, later will plant squash and okra. I have not been able to get a negro man, because they have steady jobs. So I had a chance to use a 9th Grade <sup>Boy</sup> who lives in the

next block, He is pretty good but not like a regular yard man. Right now have the yard in pretty good shape.

I heard from Chas. Spencer who is now a corporal at Tampa Florida and I believe he said he was training on B-17. He had a vacation and went to Houston, Bryan, Temple, Waco. He mentioned seeing a little teacher at Waco. He said he would write you.

One of the teacher's who taught in my building, knew your roommate at Sherman, Lt. John Fauts who was from Calif. He was sent

to <sup>new</sup> ~~Texas~~ <sup>Mexico</sup> and then to Alamosaagado. He are going to send John your address. He got married when he got his wings.

Christine has stopped by twice from her return trip from La, (Alexandria) where she saw her husband.

Was very glad to have a short visit from Eva Louise. She came up for a Monday nite dance. We had a very good time. Of course, I would have gone to Hamlin on a week-end, but she wasn't there. She went to see Bud, and <sup>at Terrell</sup> to Dallas on week-ends. Eva Louise

looked swell. She had a cute brown tweed suit and big coat. She also had a cute red hat. She surely looked uptownish - stylish and dignified young lady.

Guess by now that you knew Paul Jr. is in the navy at Farragut Idaho. He had the mumps and was in the hospital about two wks. If he ever gets a furlough, I plan to go to Hamlin. Was sorry I did not get to see you last Sept.
