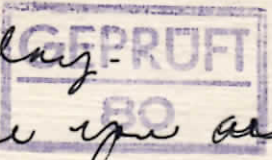
Dearest Bob,

You know the picture you gave me of those ten boys that were taken in Shalla Shalla? I hear from them all except Eddie. Do you know where he is, or where we could get in touch with him if so let your mother know when you write her. All the boys are so glad you are safe.

I must tell you we have a little girl now she was born Dec 10<sup>th</sup> her name is Linda Lee she looks just like her father, she is so cute and getting so big and fat at this moment she is in her little bed trying her best to talk. I am sending your mother a picture
