I have just received your address today, was glad to know that your folks had heard from you and that you are O K. Have thought of you many times since I heard your were reported missing.

This is Easter Morning it was twenty five years ago on Easter (April 20) morning that the bunch I was in received orders that we were to leave for home, I was in a small village in eastern France. I hope it will not be long before you get to come home.

I am still Gyp milling in California there has been lots of the Texas boys come out here since I saw you. I wish I had you here with me have the job just like you would want.

Billy is a sergeant in the Marines some where [REDACTED] I got to see him before he left in Los Angeles. I have heard that Clayton Roberts June Rhoton and Pie Wilbanks left in the last call they got a few weeks deferment for L.C.

Midland is a plaster mill town in the mountains in the desert, the winter has been perfect no cold weather they say it gets terrible hot here in the summer all the houses are airconditions.
