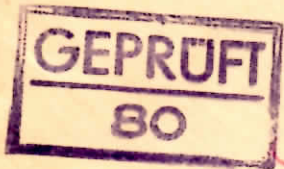

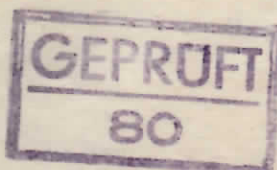

We surely do miss your letters. There are a million questions I want to ask you. Hope soon we will hear from you. Everyone ask of you. We get the prisoner of War Bulletin from American Red Cross and it gives us some information and description of camp locations. Have you been well? Are you getting our letters? We sent the second order of tobacco with the label for packages to you.

Mrs. Kodis asked me to send two kodak pictures in my letter of her little daughter, Linda Lee. We recently heard that Bill, Ed, "Bob", "Red" were in the same location and the good news was sent to each and all.

Charles Spencer is in Florida. He married a Bell Co. girl, Winona Gwin of Oenaville, Texas. Clifford Reynolds was sent to Lawton last week. Paul Junior spent a week end in Mobile, Alabama, so I have to chalk up another state for him.

Mrs. Brooks and Mrs. Hansen had not received an address when they wrote a month ago. We look at the crew picture often. The three kodak pictures of you made in September are good. I have all three in a picture frame.

J. E. Reynolds was here last month. [REDACTED]

We had a big rain and surely did need it. The lakes were getting low. Everyone is busy with farming, gardens, yards and etc. I wish you were here. Write soon.
