We certainly hope you have received some mail  
from us by this time. We received your address in March.  
We received your letter dated January 3rd. last week. We

come home in six weeks. We have sent you the cigarettes  
and tobacco twice, also two family packages.

We hope this new form will speed up our letters  
to you. We have had several nice rains and our garden is  
fine. I went fishing the other night and landed a ten  
pound blue catfish. We will do that plenty times later.

Hanson and Sell have had the mumps. Let us know  
if you see Eddy or any of the other boys.

Clifford Reynolds and Henry Meadows Jr. are in  
Wichita Falls. The kodak pictures we made in September

were good and have three in a long picture frame. We have  
made inquiry in regard to your uniforms and personal  
effects.
