July 29, 1944

Dearest Robert, Your letter came, dated April 20th.

Surely was glad to hear. I know you were glad to see your friend Font. Mrs. Font wrote that Bill's luck was still holding out, but her son, Vic, is reported dead. Hazel wrote that she had heard from Johnny and he had seen you.

So you are studying "abroad" - learning German and French. You sent us birthday greetings, so we must include birthday greetings to you. You haven't been home on your birthday in about three years now. We will be thinking of you and hope soon you can be home. Paul J. writes many interesting things of San Francisco. He has been there over a week, but has received no mail. It was delayed somewhere, as we were writing to him.

A good slow rain fell all day Friday, the 21st. So now everything will grow and make feed and cotton. I had a long letter from Mrs. Hansen. Also received a beautiful birth-announcement card of Lt. and Mrs. Riley's son, with a picture. Love - Mother.

On Tuesday night we had a cousin reunion. There was Pauline, John, Sharon, Grace, Joe Wallace, Roy Lee, La Verne, Winifred and Virgil Vaughn, Virgil's wife and me. Wow! We never get one foot inside of Virgil's apartment before he asks us what we want to drink, very hospitalible. They showed us some home movies taken here, in Dallas, Colorado, and New Mexico. Both Winifred and Virgil are really up there in the ladder and Joe Wallace was so impressed. Everyone asks about you. Joe Wallace is the image of Paul, Jr. and Grace looks so much like Mother, that I almost cried. Was over at Pauline's last night, as I'm having company this week-end and won't get to see them.
