Do hope you have had letters and packages from us other than the Tobacco, we have sent four so far. We are all well. "Tiny" is no longer a polliwog. He has been roving around a lot lately. He is in good health and doing fine.

You asked about a boat like Chunk's - I have one for you that is a lot better than that. It has plenty of room, comfortable seats and all dressed up with walnut rails. It rows good and will take the largest outboard motor. It took over a year to build at odd times.

Christine and daughter, Carol, visited us last week. We enjoyed their visit. Carol is two years old and plenty cute. She and I were good pals. She went everywhere with me and would cry when I left for work. Christine is well and working in Chickasha. Lula visited us too, going on to Abilene, Coleman and Valera.

Everybody is busy, good crops and weather just right. Tom Taylor at the Mill is still keeping the Coca-Cola Box filled up, he is smoothed mouth now.

We have written in regard to your clothing and personal effects, so far, we have not received a reply. Personally, I think they will be retained in storage.

We think of you so often, and your friends ask about you.
