Stalag I November 4, 1941

Dearest Mother, Dad and family,

Yesterday I received two Cigarette parcels dated May and July, and four letters. I heard from Louise, Leone, W.C. Russell and Mother. Louise's letter was the latest dated September 18. Fouts got one dated October 2.

Our library is sorely depleted now due to expansion of the camp. There isn't enough books to go around. We have two half days a week in the library. Reading is about the only thing we have to do to occupy our time. As time goes by a few more personal book parcels come in from prisoners' families, which helps. The cold weather has started and the

only warm place I have found is in bed with all my clothes piled on top.

Thank everyone that has written letters. send my love to Louise and Junior and all the family. A few Pennsylvania voter's ballots have come in lately. I am in good health yet,
