November 25, 1944

Dearest Mother and Dad,

I have received nineteen letters this month ranging from Duna's June letter to Louise's letter of August 24.

I am glad to hear that both of you managed to make a trip this last summer to see the family. I am pleased that they were all well.

Bill received the little birth announcement of his son, but no pictures.

We baked a cake for Thanksgiving Day made of crushed crackers, prunes, sugar, water and dried milk. We are planning to cook a special dinner Christmas Day.

It looks like a long, monotonous winter with dark days - too dark to read; and long

cold nights. The entertainment committee continue their difficult assignment of providing plays and sing-songs.

If you can, send pinto beans, soccerin, baking powder, Kotki uniform, under wear, socks, dog tag chain, and books preferably non-fiction.
