I am still using the saccharin every day that you sent. I have plenty of pipe tobacco and we have one good deck of playing cards left of those you have sent me.

Mulloy will be cook during Christmas week and I follow, starting the new year off. We are racking our brains devising novel or new methods of preparing our meals. We have saved

a package of Jello and some spice special for this occasion. We will have the beans you sent too.

I haven't received any books from home nor any that I ordered.

I am well. Love to all of you. Tell Jr. and Louise hello.
