Following is substance of report from Swiss Legation GERMANY dated April 21.

Legation has been unable some cases to indicate number of prisoners reaching destination stated since OKW has not furnished information. Swiss Government add that Special Inspector KADLER had been sent to north GERMANY but they have lost touch with him. Camp Inspector NAVILE endeavoring to visit Stalags VIIA, VIIB, Oflag VIIB, Ilag LAUFEN between April 23, April 29. Swiss Government observe much this information now probably out of date.

Report begins list of camps in eastern GERMANY known to have been transferred:

Stalag IIB to Stalag XB and NEURBADENBURG  
Stalag IID to Stalag XB and NEUBRANDENBURG Stalag Luft 4 to  
Stalag Luft 1, Stalag XIB and 357, Stalag VIIA, Stalag IIIA  
probably still in LUCKENWALDE or transferred to ALFENGRABOW.  
Stalag IIIB to MAERKISCH-RIETZ, Stalag IIIC to SEEFELD BEI  
WERNEUCHEN, Stalag IIIA commandment in BERLIN, work detachment  
at ZERNSDORF, hospitals BIESDORF and NEUOKOELLN Sanatorium  
BUCH Gefaerz's Lerter Strasse Stalag Luft 3 to NARLAC and NILAG  
NORD, LUCKENWALD, MOOSBURG, 1 part out off in HANMELBURG or  
evacuated to RAUM SANDERSDORF, Stalag Luft 7 to LUCKENWALDE,  
Stalag VIIIA to FALLINGBOSTEL, RESLAZ PREISING, OBERMASSFELD.

HOLZSCHLAGEN, 1 part probably with Stalag IIC in the FLOTTEL-  
 GENINGEN Stalag VIIIIB remained in NEUBERG or evacuated to  
 RADM REICHENBERG and RADM STROBING Stalag 344 part in NEGLAS  
 JIKININGEN (cut off) RADM SANDERSDORF, part remained in HANN-  
 LENSCH, ditto LUCKENWALDE, part at MÜNCHINGEN, part remained in  
 NEUBERG-LANDWISSEN or evacuated to RADM REICHENBERG, 800 sick  
 British and USA with Stalag VIII A to WELD, FERNAU, LAHART,  
 ALMOOSCH unknown. Perhaps RADM REICHENBERG work detachments in  
 OLSCHWITZ and KATTOVITZ area unknown E 715 (Stalag VIII) unknown  
 if not liberated perhaps RADM SANDERSDORF, NEGLAS, LAURAHETTEN  
 and EMANUELSDORF unknown WAB 20 and 21 and 23, W711 and W712  
 unknown if not liberated. Perhaps RADM SANDERSDORF work de-  
 tachments north of line BRUNN-WLACHENBURG cannot be checked  
 where now Stalag VIII C as the were evacuated to ZIEHENHAIN  
 and FALLINGSBONTEL probably completely liberated Stalag IIA  
 as they were brought to Wehrkreis XI, probably liberated  
 Stalag IIB as they were brought to Wehrkreis XI, probably  
 liberated military prison GRACHEN whereabout still being  
 investigated, possibly NEUBERG-LANDWISSEN Oflag 64 LUCKENWALDE  
 and HANKELENSCH BRITWILAT.
