Caravan Summary: We Journey over to the *Ames Automotive Foundation Museum* in Marlborough, for a mid-morning visit. This one is a little different as <u>We have two groups traveling from two separate starting locations</u>, to meet up at the museum. One from the Keene, NH area and one from the Milford, NH area. The two groups will converge at the museum at 9:45AM. The Museum tour begins at **10:00 AM** and should last around 2 hours. For those wishing to join us we will be stopping for lunch (and Ice Cream) after our museum visit at Kimball Farms in Jaffery! No Season raffle tickets will be available for this event

This guided tour exclusive visit is a rare opportunity to see some of the most incredible cars from the last 100 years. Since a majority of these cars have original paint and MUST not be damaged, we kindly insist that you please avoid large belt buckles, dangling jewelry, wearable cameras, and anything else that could inadvertently scratch, ding, or otherwise damage a vehicle while walking around the collection. No Belt knifes, phone holding cases or anything that could potentially damage these cars! Please make sure if you are wearing anything with a zipper it is properly covered!

9:00 AM Burger King Parking area, Kohls Plaza off West St, Keene

Departure Time: 9:30 AM

Travel: Approx 30-minute travel time

Arrival: 9:45 AM both groups assemble. The guided Museum tour starts at 10:00 AM and should last around two hours.

Lunch: After the museum visit Kimball Farms in Jaffery

Return trip: Everyone is free to leave at their own discretion.

SONHC Carvan Rules & Safety Guidelines

- 1. If this is your first caravan, be cautious and stay alert! Be aware of the car in front of you at all times DO NOT GET SPREAD OUT, but leave enough distance between your car and the one you're following! Remember, it's a precession not a race! Also try and know if the car in front of you is an automatic or a standard, as those of us with standards don't always use the brakes alone to slow the car!
- 2. <u>USE YOUR TURN SIGNAL AT ALL TIMES</u>! Every Car, Every turn! Cars as close as three back from the ride leader will not be able to see the leader's turn signals and it's imperative that you help out the riders behind you by giving them a heads up! use your turn signals!
- 3. <u>Be considerate of all your fellow Corvette's</u>, No burn outs, engine revving or any behavior other than, us all behaving like choir boys and girls on our first day of drivers Ed!
- 4. There is never any passing within the Caravan and we'll try and stay close to the speed limits at all times! We'll be traveling lots of main two-lane roads and back roads and should encounter just a few city streets, however if we get separated by stop lights, The group leader will pull over at the first safe place large enough for the waiting cars to stop and remain waiting till everyone gets through the lights.

 DO NOT RUN traffic lights!
- 5. **If at any time you encounter a problem**, go ahead and pull over and the caboose car will stop and check on you and the caravan will continue and you can catch up at the next scheduled stop.

- 6. We will use *channel 5* for anyone bringing their own radios. **If you get separated, don't despair**, as the group will pull over and wait for you as soon as there is a safe location to do so.
- 7. When you pull over to the side of the road, stop with your wheels turned out towards the road so that when you see its all clear to proceed, you can pull back into formation quickly. Look for the car behind you to enter back into traffic and proceed in front of them! The caravan goes back into traffic from the back to the front! If we stop, do your part and pull off the side of the road and watch behind you for the cars to pull back into traffic. We always enter back into traffic from the back of the caravan to the front!

Remember you are always representing the SO NH CORVETTE club, so please always be courteous and respectful to anyone and everyone you may encounter. Our reputation is always on display!

Directions

East group starting at the Tractor Supply parking lot in Milford

- 1. Depart parking lot and take Rt101A west
- 2. Continue on Rt101 all the way into Marlborough
- 3. Turn left at the intersection of Rt124 (just up the street past the Marlborough Convenience store on the left)
- 4. Follow Rt 124 to Bonney Rd. Bonney Rd will be the first left road after Underwood Rd. There is only a very small road sign at Bonney Rd!
- 5. Turn down Bonney Rd (A hard packed Dirt Rd) and look for the entrance to the museum which will be on your left.

Directions

West group starting at the Burger King Parking are in the Kohls parking lot in Keene

- 1. Depart Parking Lot and turn left onto West St.
- 2. Turn left Rt9w and follow to intersection of rt101
- 3. Turn left onto Rt101 (rt10) and follow into Marlborough.
- 4. Turn right onto rt124.
- 5. Follow Rt 124 to Bonney Rd. Bonney Rd will be the first left road after Underwood Rd. There is only a very small road sign at Bonney Rd!
- 6. Turn down Bonney Rd (A hard packed Dirt Rd) and look for the entrance to the museum which will be on your left.
