Trip Itinerary, Directions & Rules

Today's trip miles awarded: 100 points

Today's Caravan: We travel from our starting point at *Market Basket store on Daniel Webster Highway, Nashua NH* and journey down to the **American Heritage Museum** in Hudson, MA. Our planned visit will include enjoying all three-museum buildings. The American Heritage Museum, The Historic Aviation Hangar and Classic Automobile Barn on the grounds all will be opened up for this special event weekend! **Our visit will coincide with day two of the museums, World War 2 Pacific Reenactment event that will take place on and around the grounds of the museum between 9:00AM & 5:00PM**

Starting point: *Market Basket, Daniel Webster Hwy, Nashua.* We ask that you please arrive between 7:00-7:15 AM allowing you time to mingle and meet others. So please ensure that we check you in to acknowledge your arrival to receive your **100 trip points** for this event! After check in, you will be able to purchase your **5/90 raffle tickets** (\$5 per ticket, \$20 max per couple) for those wishing to get in on the season long raffle! We will hold a short meeting at 7:20 AM just before departure to go over any last-minute trip details and answer any questions.

We recommend everyone use the restroom facilities at MB. We do not have a scheduled stop enroute to the destination.

We depart promptly at **7:30AM:** and part of our journey will take us on Route 3 & Route 495!

Departure: 7:30 AM It is approximately a 1-hour trip down to Hudson, NH. We will be cruising a combination of both highways and back roads on our journey. Our arrival time should put us there just before they open at **9:00 AM!**

Arrival: The museum opens at 9:00 AM and sits at the end of the long access rd. it is going to be an extremely busy at the museum, as our visit coincides with day two of the museums WW2 in the Pacific reenactment! Here is the schedule and timeline of the day's events:

9:30am – 4:30pm

World War II Tank & Half Track Rides & Driving – Tank Driving Area

Tank Driving Experiences and Tank Rides aboard the M4 Sherman, M24 Chaffee, & M36 Jackson WWII tanks and WWII M3 Half Track will be taking place all day! Details on pricing available in the center of this program.

10:00am – 4:00pm

War Gaming Demonstrations – Aircraft Hangar

Guides will be demonstrating tabletop strategy war gaming in the aircraft hangar through the day, explaining how games are played and how you can get a start in this unique hobby.

10:00am – 4:00pm

Paint-A-Tank – Inside Aircraft Hangar

For kids of all ages – come to the Paint-a-Tank area in the hangar to get a 3D printed tank to paint in the battle colors YOU choose! \$5 donation per tank.

1:00pm – 2:00pm

Battle of Okinawa WWII Pacific Battle Re-Enactment – Runway and Re-Enactment Field

A daily battle re-enactment between American and Imperial Japanese forces on the runway and performance field area. Battle will also feature aircraft demonstrations from the Stinson OY-1 and replica Japanese A6M Zero (weather permitting)

5:00pm – All museum grounds and buildings close for the day.

Tickets can be pre-purchased for this event on line or at the door on the day of the event. We strongly recommend, due to the overwhelming popularity of this event to pre-purchase your tickets beforehand!

Food & Lunch: We recommend everyone bring, chairs and a cooler with food and beverages, as our visit may end up being an extended one. And, for those who after want to join us at our designated food stop after departing the museum, **Kimball Farm** in Lancaster will be our designated location stop for this trip. (yup there's Ice Cream involved) Their menu is enclosed after the directions.

Our Park Visit: We will be at the museum for approximately 4-5 **hours**, however everyone is free to explore on their own the museum buildings and outdoor attractions on premise and or leave at their own discretion at any time.

Journey Home: We will depart Kimball Farm heading straight back to New Hampshire after lunch with no further planned stops.

Below is the list of rules and they are in place to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable ride experience! Do not glance over them: be aware of each rule and your responsibility in following them! Our ride participant's safety and the safety of drivers we encounter must always come first! By following the few simple rules, we have and staying alert at all times is the best remedy to prevent an incident or worse an accident. **Most accidents that occur on caravans are rear end collisions!**

Lastly, we ask that you always behave with the highest level of integrity and dignity, as our club's reputation wherever we go is always on display!

Rules & Safety Guidelines

1. If this is your first caravan, be cautious and stay alert! Be aware of the car in front of you at all times!
DO NOT GET SPREAD OUT! Keep the correct proximity to the car in front of you. **You CANNOT ALLOW THE CARAVAN TO GET SPREAD OUT!** It's imperative for everyone's enjoyment **AND** safety to stay close to the car you are following. If not, something called the **boomerang effect** takes place and it's a major cause of accidents in caravans, As the cars in the back are speeding up to make up distance with the cars in the front, the cars in the front may be slowing down and that is never a good scenario! Remember, We're a precession and never a race! Also try and know if the car in front of you is an automatic or a standard, as those of us with standards don't always use the brakes alone to slow the car!
2. **USE YOUR TURN SIGNAL AT ALL TIMES!** Every Car, Every turn! Cars as close as three back from the ride leader will not be able to see the leader's turn signals and it's imperative that you help out the riders behind you by giving them a heads up! **use your turn signals!**
3. **Be considerate of all your fellow Corvette's,** No burn outs, engine revving or any behavior other than, us all behaving like choir boys and girls on our first day of drivers Ed!
4. **There is never any passing within the Caravan and we'll try and stay close to the speed limits at all times!** We travel a variety of different types of roads and sometimes we will encounter traffic lights! Don't despair if you get separated by red lights, The group leader will pull over at the first safe place large enough for the waiting cars to stop and remain waiting till everyone gets through the lights. **DO NOT RUN traffic lights!**
5. **If at any time you encounter a problem,** go ahead and pull over and the caboose car will stop and check on you and the caravan will continue and you can catch up at the next scheduled stop.
6. **If you get separated, don't despair,** as the group will pull over and wait for you as soon as there is a safe location to do so.
7. **When you pull over to the side of the road, stop with your wheels turned out towards the road** so that when you see it's all clear to proceed, you can pull back into formation quickly. Look for the car behind you to enter back into traffic and proceed in front of them! **The caravan goes back into traffic from the back to the front! If we stop, do your part and pull off the side of the road and watch behind you for the cars to pull back into traffic.**
8. **DO NOT EVER TAKE OFF IN FRONT OF THE GROUPS LEAD CAR!** Unless you are leaving the caravan and heading straight home! And if you are leaving, please communicate with the ride leaders so we are not looking for you!

Directions to AH Museum

1. Depart Market Basket parking lot, turning right onto the DW highway and go through three or four sets of lights, take the Rt3 access just past Jordan's Furniture. Get in the left-hand lane and take the Southbound onramp onto Route 3S. follow down to the 495S Exit.
2. Exit Rt 495 South Remain on 495S to Exit 70 and at the end of the off ramp turn right, onto Rt 117
3. Turn right onto Wheeler Rd and follow.
4. Turn right onto Gleasondale Rd and follow.
5. Turn left onto Boon Rd.
6. At four ways stop sign, with Whitman Rd, continue straight across now on Sudbury Rd and continue until intersection of State Rd.
7. At intersection take a very sharp right hand turn onto State Rd and follow.
8. The museum entrance will be on your right with a sign at the entrance to the museum.
9. Take the access road all the way to the museum at the end.
10. We will look to park our cars in a row as we did last year.

Directions from AHM to Kimball Farm

1. Turn right out of the museum Rd onto Main Street and follow.
2. At the light just past the Mobil station on the left, slightly bear right onto Cox St. and follow.
3. At the 4 ways stop sign intersection, turn right onto Old Stow Rd and follow, as road name changes to Hudson Rd.
4. At the end of Hudson Rd, turn left onto Rt117 and remain on Rt117 until the intersection of Rt70N.
5. Turn right onto Rt70N and follow, Kimball Farm will be on your right just a short ways up the road.
