FEATURED ARTICLE: ZORA'S 1 CORVETTE AND ALMOST PORCHE OWNER

Despite having played such a huge pivotal role in the early development of the Chevrolet Corvette...Zora Arkus-Duntov only owned one Corvette his entire life! And, actually that one Corvette was a gift, given to him by Chevrolet upon his retirement! A 1974 Big Block 454 Stingray! One might think that someone of his stature and direct involvement in the car's development would have possessed several over his long and illustrious career. But he didn't! And as it turned out, he didn't need to. As his position within the company gained him access to any GM vehicle including many Corvettes, both

production and experimental to use as daily drivers!
Why buy when you can simply borrow!
His one personally owned Corvette has been recently retouched by the Corvette Museum, not restored because they wanted to preserve many of the unique and historical attributes of the car to Zora when he last owned it. After a frame off refresh, done by the Museum restoration department, the car now currently resides on display in the Bowling Green National Corvette Museum Hall of Fame exhibit.

But Did You Know... Duntov's story was one that almost never got written... Chevrolet almost lost Duntov numerous times in his early years at GM to Porche, who Duntov had already had a great relationship with. He had Successfully raced Porches in the mid-1950s having secured two class wins in Lemans while piloting Porche 550 Spiders.

This coupled with the fact that at the time GM had completely pulled out of all competitive racing, it left Duntov on having to decide a future between the two



companies. Or did it? As we're all well aware, Duntov's career at GM began to take hold, and he began to work in earnest on upgrading the Corvette's performance, he was also at the same time continuing to work with Porche engineers in Germany on issues they were having on their new model 356 street car. The work he was doing for them was considered unofficial, but the engineering fixes that he provided, solved several big issues on their new 356 model, and included addressing the huge issue of oversteer that plagued the car and was considered so instrumental to the future success of the car, they offered to give him one for free! However, he declined... as he knew he couldn't very well be driving around Detroit employed by Chevrolet developing

performance upgrades on the Corvette, all the while seen driving a new Porche!

But it was through his direct involvement with Porche and convincing them to add a front sway bar to all the new Porches, based off his engineering tests he provided Porche with, while still employed at Chevrolet, that gave their cars the much-needed improvement in the handling characteristics that would later go on to become legendary. And, this relationship with Porche continued on for many of the same years he was at Chevrolet busy adding the performance bite to the early year Corvettes!

Was a Porche 356 **Zo6** perhaps closer to happening than anyone may have ever realized!


OUR BEAUTIFUL NEW HAMPSHIRE

Finding discontinued Parts on E-Bay

For anyone who happens to own an C7 and earlier generation, and who may have run into the situation where a particular part has been discontinued by GM and is not showing as available anywhere through the normal parts supplier channels... There is still one resource available that perhaps might bail you out! But only with some due diligence on your end.

E-Bay Motors! A multibillion dollar a year business that can under the right circumstances be your savior and help you get that much needed illusive discontinued part. But this process does come with potential pitfalls! The statement that knowledge is power is ever so true



when it comes to browsing and eventually purchasing car parts through E-Bay. You'll need to possess much more item information than the seller will potentially list!

Understanding that many of the sellers listing items for sale, probably doesn't know the many exact specifics of everything that they have listed. Many times, the information they provide on a listing is nothing more than info they themselves have pulled from Google or some other on-line resource... and may or may not contain complete accurate information.

But by you doing your homework and possessing as much specific information about the part you need

(exact year, specific model, GM original part numbers) beforehand ca lead to not having a bevy of

frustrations, returned orders or even worse out of pocket expenses, and all ending without addressing your need!



There are some great sources available for you to be able to learn about the specifics of your vehicle and there is no better place to start than manufacturer itself. **GMParts.com** can be a great resource for not only items still available, but it also can also provide you with the original GM part numbers on the many discontinued ones as well! You can also browse **ACDelco.com** as another, to find the often-discontinued electrical parts on your car. In both cases, you are

able to provide your vehicle VIN number and the system will often return with the exact part number you're looking to find! Also, the GM Support center website exists as another available resource that might be able to help you out in determining your exact part number you require. And, having the correct part number is almost vital when shopping on E-Bay!

Next it is recommended that you only buy from a super reliable party that has nothing but excellent seller ratings and customer reviews, offers buyer friendly terms (Some sort of return policy is a must) and is willing to answer any specific questions you might ask. Once you have found the right seller, and determined their item listed to be the correct part you need... **do not procrastinate!**...

Communicate with the seller, address any concerns you might have and buy the part and get your need addressed. And remember... Chances are, if you're looking for that specific discontinued part, there are numerous other Covette owners out there also looking for the exact same piece you need!





T-Tops and Targa Top's ... Squeaks and Groans.

Whether you are a T-roof fan, a targa top fan or a full-blown convertible fan, the saying that... Variety is the spice of life... certainly can be applied here. All three of these designs bring Corvette owners the ability to enjoy open air driving and, in many ways, allow us to feel better connected with our outdoor surroundings! Fact is, for most all Corvette owners the ability to enjoy top-down therapy has been something that has been there since the very beginning. The 1953 Corvette was after all a convertible! And, unless you happen to own a C5 or C6 Z06 or ZR1 (What a problem to have) Corvettes have always offered some sort of optional open-air cockpit design.

Now for those of us who happen to own older cars, with age comes normal wear and tear! T-roofs, targa tops and even convertibles don't fit quite as tight or work as well as they once did when new. Perhaps a water leak, or some undesirable squeaks and groins that have now become a bit more than just slightly annoying!

But the good news is with most all of these age-related issues, there are remedy's to be had that can directly address these problems! Fixes that will bring them back to like new condition! Sometimes it's nothing more than applying a lubricant to the roof pins to quiet them down. Sometimes its will require a bit more effort!

But, be weary as this is one project that can't just turn out simply OK! It must be done correctly or its all for not! Often, it's the rubber moldings themselves that are the cause of the leaks, squeaks and loose-fitting tops that happen with age. The Dried up, ripped and often cracked rubber moldings many times need replacement to correct these issues. Just like the rubber on your tires, atmospheric elements over time erode the rubber, drying them out and greatly reducing their flexibility!

And while there are several aftermarket companies that can sell you these replacement rubber moldings directly, be cautious as many times they are not anywhere close to an exact fit or the quality of the original OEM pieces. they are either loose fitting, need to be trimmed or even cut right out the box to fit! And, the manufacturing tolerances let's just say leave a lot to be desired when it comes to fit! If you are going to tackle this project yourself, do not cheap out here, and only use products from a reputable company! The Price will be a good indicator to the quality you are going to get. High quality moldings are expensive and do not come cheap!

Better yet, forgo this do it yourself project and consider having this replacement process performed by the professionals who have lots and lots of experience in repairing Corvette roofs and know where to go to get the highest quality moldings to use!

Perhaps give one of our Partnering Professionals who specialize in Corvettes a call and get this issue addressed over the coming winter months!
