# **Season-Long Participation**


Here's how it will work. Each of our caravans will have an assigned points value that will be rewarded for everyone who both registers and then attends the start of each event. These points will vary dependent on the length and type of event. We will keep track of everyone's participation and at the end of the year award those with the highest season-long point totals! And those who participate in the Season-Long Scavenger Hunt will also gain additional points that will be added into your season totals as well!

**Now...** if you register for a specific event and do not cancel your reservation at least a day prior to the scheduled event, not only will you not be credited the points for that event, you will have those points deducted from your season's total.

Example: A Caravan to Hampton Beach originating from Manchester. Total points for someone who reg-

isters and then arrives at the starting point would be **100 points!** If someone were to register but not cancel 24 hours prior to the event would be a "No Show" and they would **lose 100 points** towards their season-long point total.

Why are we doing this? A couple of reasons. We understand that sometimes things come up at the last minute that keep members from participating in an event they have committed to attending. One of the frustrating things we seem to always encounter on the day of the event is several "No Shows."

Why would we care? After all, this is supposed to be a fun diversion.

Well, in most all cases we have committed to the venues (restaurants and destinations) we are visiting a certain number of participants. In many cases, because of the size of our group, special accommodations are made in order for them to fit our group into their location. When we arrive with less, it can be an inconvenience for them. Being able to provide an accurate headcount is important to our ability to possibly return in the future and it also speaks to the reputation of our group!

Secondly, and more importantly, we wanted to come up with a way to reward members who consistently come out and support what we do! Now, for those who are only able to commit to just a few events, all is not lost. If you attend at least one caravan and receive points for that event, you'll be added into an end-of-season lottery drawing that will make you eligible to receive one of the same awards as the top participating teams at the end of the season!



### **New Destinations**



One of the fun things we get to do over the long winter months is look at potential new places we've never taken the group to before! And while we've

visited numerous exciting and fun destinations in the past, there are always new possibilities out there to consider adding to our calendar! For a place to make it onto our event schedule, certain criteria must be met:

- Is the destination conducive to hosting a large group of cars and people?
- Is there adequate parking? (Always one of the first considerations.)
- Caravan length? (Another big consideration!) There are many great places to visit in New England that are more than 3 hours away. Visiting them would most likely result in a ten-hour or longer day!
- Is there an attraction that would interest the group?





- Is the attraction affordable, such as the cost for a museum or park?
- Are there locations on our route that will accommodate our pit-stops?
- Are the roads conducive to making for an enjoyable trip?
- Is there an available a restaurant that can handle a large group and is interested in being our host?
- Is there a location that we could picnic at?

For a location to make onto our schedule, the majority, if not all, of these questions must be answered with a yes!

In 2024, we're happy to say we were able to add six new destinations! 88 MPH museum, Hubbardston, MA (2023 rain out); Portland, ME; Patriot Place, Foxborough, MA; Wright Museum, Wolfeboro, NH; The Back to the Beach Parade, Old Orchard Beach, ME; New England Dragway, Epping NH; and finally, Parkers Maple Barn, in Mason, NH!

As we jump ahead to 2025, we'll be looking at adding a couple of overnight caravans to the schedule!

# **QR Code Event Registration**

We're attempting to go high tech! One of the more difficult tasks we have, I say "we," I mean Sharon, who gets to everyone and signs them in the morning of an event, so we

know who has attended. With some events having over 75 people, this is both a daunting and overwhelming task for just one person. Now, with the introduction of the season-long points program, it's imperative we get everyone included on the morning of the event without exception. A way we are going to do this (here comes the techy part), is when anyone registers for a particular event, the confirmation e-mail you receive back will contain a QR code. It will be unique to just you (both of you if you are attending as a couple). All you need to do is keep the registration confirmation e-mail (or take a picture of the QR code and keep it on your phone) and on the morning of the event simply show us the e-mail, we'll

scan the QR code and, just like that, you'll be registered as attending along with awarding the points for that day's event automatically into your seasonlong points account.
