





SO ME CORVETTES

Corvette Fun Facts — C6 (2005–2013)



- 1. LS2 Engine Introduction: The 2005 C6 Corvette marked the debut of the legendary LS2 engine, which became a staple in Corvette performance. Additional engine models through the years where the LS2 (2005–2007), the LS3 (2008–2013), the LS7 (2006–2013), and the LS9 (2009–2013)
- **2. Fixed Headlights:** The C6 was the first Corvette since 1962 to feature fixed headlights, giving it a distinctive look.
- **3. Push-to-Start Ignition:** The C6 was also the first Corvette to feature push-to-start ignition, adding a modern touch.
- **4. Z06's LS7 Dry-Sump Engine:** The C6 Z06 boasted the LS7, the first dry-sump engine in a Corvette, enhancing track performance.
- **5. Titanium Rods:** The LS7 engine was the first production GM engine to use titanium connecting rods, contributing to its high-revving capabilities.

- **6. Lowest Production Year:** In 2009, only 16,956 C6 Corvettes were produced, making it the lowest production year since 1962.
- 7. Wide Rear Tires: The C6 featured wider rear tires than its predecessor, improving traction and handling.
- **8. Improved Aerodynamics:** Engineers refined the C6's aerodynamics, resulting in better stability at high speeds.
- Magnetic Selective Ride Control: The C6 Z51
 package introduced Magnetic Selective Ride
 Control, allowing adaptive suspension adjustments.
- 10. Carbon Fiber Roof Option: The C6 offered an optional carbon fiber roof panel, reducing weight and lowering the center of gravity.
