# Kancamagus Here We Come!

We've all driven across the Kancamagus Highway numerous times. It's one of New Hampshire's most well-travelled and scenic roads! Did you know the history of the Kancamagus dates to the indigenous Native tribes in the 1600s? In 1627, a man named Passaconaway united 17 Indian tribes across the region and formed the Penacook Confederacy. He became the tribal leader and brought peace to the region. His grandson, Kancamagus, would later rule over the tribes and lead the battle against the white Englishmen who invaded the area around 1690, before being forced to flee to Canada. Back in the early 1800s, two dead-end town roads were formed, one in Lincoln and the other in Passaconaway; they would finally be connected in 1937, forming one continuous road between the two towns. In 1959, the road was opened as a dirt road and was finally paved in 1964. Even after the road was paved, it would close during the winter months as it was considered too dangerous to navigate during the harshest times of the year. The road was first plowed during the winter of 1966, which allowed traffic to navigate between Lincoln and Conway. In 2009, the road celebrated it's 50th anniversary. We return for our fourth caravan across the Kanc on September 15th.
