## Harvey Earl .. The Father of the Corvette and so much more

We all know Harley Earl as the father of our beloved Corvettes. But long before Earl created our two seat sports car in the early 1950's, He already had established a distinguished career at GM.. Here are just a few of the designs and innovations that were the results of Harley Earls 31 years with GM.

Harley Earl, generally considered the father of American automotive design, was born in Los Angeles, California, in 1893. In the late 1920s, Earl's design talent caught the eye of General Motors Chairman Alfred Sloan, who offered him a position directing the styling of all GM car lines. Earl accepted, moved to Detroit, and soon wielded unprecedented control over GM's new product development.





During Earl's 31-year career with the company, General Motors reigned supreme as an industry leader. Under his direction, designers and stylists pioneered countless innovations which propelled the company to the forefront of automotive design. Some of Earls design idea's and concepts are still utilized to this day

Earl pioneered and introduced the process of using clay models for designers to lay out new car models, saving time and energy n bringing new car models to reality. In 1956 Earl designed In place of rear view mirrors, a functional TV camera that transmitted the rear view to a small screen on the dashboard of the 1956 Buick Centurion show car.

Earl engineered the groundbreaking 1951 LeSabre concept car that boasted an innovative new windshield design in which the glass curved sharply at the ends to meet the windshield pillars. This gave a futuristic look and a panoramic view. The design soon saw production on the 1953 Cadillac Eldorado and the 1953 Oldsmobile Fiesta, and it



quickly became de rigueur on most American cars in the 1950s.



Harvey Earl died on April 10th 1969.. A life well lived for sure!

# The Story of GM & Chevrolet

Corvette's haven't always been the showcase center for Chevrolet, in fact while the Corvette has gone on to become a Legendary benchmark for the bowtie company for seventy plus years, much history both good and bad went on at Chevrolet during the beginning 45 years prior to the Corvette's invention by Harley Earl.

Actually in the beginning, Chevy wasn't even a part of GM during its earliest years! In 1908

William "Crapo" Durant and business partner Charles Stewart Mott, founded a company called General Motors. (Durant was in 1900 the largest seller of horse drawn buggies in the country) In naming the company he literally stole the name "General" from The General Electric Company. The corporation was intended simply as a holding company for the Buick Car Company which he had recently bought! With some limited sales success for both Buick and GM,



within two years Durant bought some of the biggest names in the automotive industry including Oldsmobile, Cadillac, Oakland (later known as Pontiac) and the company that produced the predecessor to the GMC Truck and brought them all under the GM umbrella. But it came with a heavy price as in 1910, Durant lost control of the company to a banker's trust as a result of the \$15 million debt incurred through these company acquisitions. As a result Durant was pushed out and left the firm and along with Swiss race car driver Louis Chevrolet created the Chevrolet Motor Company in 1911, and began producing and selling six almost identical models over the next three years. But Durant wasn't happy and still wanted more, he wanted back to the company he had founded 7 years earlier along with revenge for his ouster, and through a stock buyback campaign in 1915 returned to lead GM once again and bringing the Chevrolet company into the GM fold. Still angered by his earlier ouster, not only did he once again sit on top of the company he had founded but upon his return, he had acquired enough stock leverage to allow the Chevrolet company to buy GM! CHEVROLET ACTUALLY OWNED GM. NOT THE OTHER WAY AROUND!

Another interesting tid bit of early GM history, in GM's second year of existence there was an agreement in place between Durant's GM and Henry Ford to buy the Ford Motor Company and also bring it too under the GM umbrella of companies, as long as Henry Ford could keep the farm implement division. However the Banks were still nervous about the evolving auto motive industry, and refused to give Durant the 2 million dollar down payment loan to buy Ford. So literally one bank president was the only reason Ford didn't become part of GM. Durant remained at GM until another severe downturn in the economy forced his ouster for the last time in 1920!



While Louis Chevrolet has always received the majority of the credit in forming the Chevrolet Corporation, It was Durant who played a much larger role through his financial wealth, savvy leadership and cut throat determination in driving both Chevrolet and GM to success

As time went on both GM and The Chevrolet division grew both achieving incredible sales numbers and profits during the next 60 years with GM becoming the largest

automotive manufacturer in the US, and in the world until world wide sales were overtaken by Tovota in 1980. In the late 2000's GM once again asserted its presence as the world leader in innovation and design, and to this day sits atop the US automotive manufacturers for profitability and production!

GM along with Chevrolet has had numerous innovations (And some Busts) to its credit (besides the Corvette) in advancing the automotive industry. Here are just a

In 1920 then GM President Alfred P. Sloan Initiated the policy of introducing newly designed car models each year.

In 1921 a GM engineer discovered leaded gasoline by adding a chemical agent to gas that could deter engine knock, a major problem for early internal combustion engines and It also created the ability to build higher combustion engines increasing performance. (GM brass also knew at the time of the health risks associated with the fuel additive called tetraethyl lead but did it anyway) The same engineer also developed something called R12 chlorofluorocarbon, which was the chemical used in every single automotive air conditioning system until the 1980's. R12 refrigerant has since been banned world wide due to the catastrophic damage it has done to the upper atmosphere's ozone layer.

In 1926 GM was the first automotive company to offer life insurance to all its employees.



In 1927 Here's a big one .. Sloan hired California coachbuilder Harley Earl to head up its Art and Colour department.. He'd go on to do something pretty big later on. Just can't remember what

In 1935 GM's labor force participated in the formation of the United Auto Workers union or UAW. One year later the union went on strike for over 370 days idling 7 GM plants bringing production to a stand

In 1937 Chevrolet produces its 10 millionth vehicle! GM will go on to produce over 500 million vehicles during its existence!

In 1939 Oldsmobile introduced the first 2 speed automatic transmission, called the Hydramatic transmission

In the 1940's GM lead the change from automotive production to war time equipment producer critical in helping to defeat the enemy in WW2. However there is also a footnote to this as then GM president was also a supporter of Hitler and in fact many of the German war vehicles were produced by The Opel company, a then owned GM company.

In 1953 Harley Farl developed a 2 seat sports car called the Corvette the rest we all knowledge.

In 1960. Chevrolet introduces the Chevy Corvair, a rear engine air cooled engine. It flopped due to public outcry over safety issues

In 1962 GM developed the first Turbo charged engine in the Old's Cutlass Turbo Fire.

In 1966 GM introduced the first hydrogen fuel cell car ever produced called the Electrovan.



In the 1970's GM was the first manufacturer to install passenger side airbags

In the 1970's During the Oil embargo, GM produced and marketed more small gas efficient models, such as the Chevy Vega and Chevy Chevette along with the same chassis' offered in other GM lines, but all resulted in poor sales and ultimately failed due to the poor overall quality and workmanship of the cars.

In the 1980's GM began pushing the benefits of the diesel engine in its cars. Another industry first! But

due to poor reliability, pulled the plug on production shortly after it began.

In 1990's GM began the development of electric powered vehicles with the introduction of the GM EV1 and the later release of the Chevy Volt, a somewhat successful first of its kind Electric powered car. For the first time ever Chevy Trucks outsold Chevy Cars for the entire year!

In the late 2000's GM reorganizes and eventually filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection, borrowing billions of dollars from the US government to enable the company to continue. It emerged out of bankrupt-

cy as a once again profitable company repaying its loans back to the US Government.


Today GM is once again sitting on top of the US auto manufacturers as the largest most profitable manufacturer in the country.. Oh and it builds a pretty neat little sports car too!

Where did the Iconic Chevy Bowtie come from?



The co-founder of the Chevrolet company, William C. Durant, was a world traveler. During a visit to Paris, he was struck by the mesmerizing design on the hotel wallpaper. He tore a piece of the wallpaper and brought it back to the States, where it served as inspiration for the Chevy bowtie logo.
