The details of the event are listed below.

Starting location: Hooksett, NB Service Plaza, RT93 Hooksett, NH

Meet time: 7:45 AM (be on time)

Departure: 8:15 AM

Trip: We travel to **Meredith, NH** and to meet up with our hosts who will then lead us on the 30-minute ride over to the Club Motorsport park in Tamworth for the day's activities.

Upon completion of the track events for those who would like to join us, we will be planning on heading back to Meredith for an optional late lunch before departing for home.

YOU WILL GET AN EMAIL IN THE AM IF IT IS RAINING AND POSTPONED. HAVE FUN EVERYONE!!!!

On Saturday, June 20th we have been invited back to Club Motorsports - to do a couple of Parade laps around their 2.5,15 turn road course. Then we are invited (for those that want to) to stick around and watch the members of this private club go around the road course. Club Motorsports is located at 780 Ossipee Mountain Highway in Tamworth. Club Motorsports is New England's premiere country club for car enthusiasts. **ALL LRCC & SONHC members will be required to sign a waiver.**

Here are some final details.

Though you may have already driven by the Club Motorsports driveway, for location purposes, the actual mileage from where Route 13 heads East (toward Tamworth) is 1.3. You will see and enter at the "Enter Here" sign. Keep left, driving by the gate, toward a small building on the right. It is there that the waivers will be passed out, signed, then collected. As mentioned, arriving early (by at least 10:30 or earlier) is recommended for that purpose.

From there you'll likely be instructed to park in the big paddock to the left. Before parking, however, you may take that time to drive up the access road to the summit for a fabulous view of Mt. Chocorua. Or you can park, then walk to the right side of the paddock where you see a white trailer (used as a classroom) and on that day members will be parked.

Before your event begins, there will be a driver meeting at that paddock. Depending on the number of vehicles participating, and experience, you may be broken up in to groups. Close to noon, you will all line up at the pit row.

Once on the course, to all the vehicles in each group please keep up with the vehicle in front you. (NOTE: I did not attend last year BUT I was told they actually went at least 60 mph if not faster and they did 2 or 3 laps).

1. If this is your first caravan, be cautious and stay alert! Be aware of the car in front of you at all times! **DO NOT GET SPREAD OUT, but leave enough distance between your car and the one you're following!** Remember, it's a procession not a race! Also try and know if the car in front of you is an automatic or a standard, as those of us with standards don't always use the brakes alone to slow the car!
2. **USE YOUR TURN SIGNAL AT ALL TIMES!** Every Car, Every turn! Cars as close as three back from the ride leader will not be able to see the leader's turn signals and it's imperative that you help out the riders behind you by giving them a heads up! use your turn signals!
3. **Be considerate of all your fellow Corvette's.** No burn outs, engine revving or any behavior other than, us all behaving like choir boys and girls on our first day of drivers Ed!
4. **There is never any passing within the Caravan and we'll try and stay close to the speed limits at all times!** We'll be traveling lots of main two-lane roads and back roads and should encounter just a few city streets, however if we get separated by stop lights, The group leader will pull over at the first safe place large enough for the waiting cars to stop and remain waiting till everyone gets through the lights. **DO NOT RUN traffic lights!**
5. **At our designated stops, remember to pull all the way into any parking area** as quickly and safely as possible to get the stopped cars behind you off the highway. Due to the size of our groups, every stop will take time to get everyone off the Highway! Always try and back into your parking spaces as it makes it easier when we leave the location.
6. **If at any time you encounter a problem,** go ahead and pull over and the caboose car will stop and check on you and the caravan will continue and you can catch up at the next scheduled stop.
7. We will use ***channel 5*** for anyone bringing their own radios. **If you get separated, don't despair,** as the group will pull over and wait for you as soon as there is a safe location to do so.
8. **When you pull over to the side of the road, stop with your wheels turned out towards the road** so that when you see it's all clear to proceed, you can pull back into formation quickly. Look for the car behind you to enter back into traffic and proceed in front of them **The caravan always goes back into traffic from the back to the front!** If we stop, do your part and pull off the side of the road and watch behind you for the cars to pull back into traffic.
9. **DO NOT EVER TAKE OFF IN FRONT OF THE GROUPS LEAD CAR!** Unless you are leaving the caravan and heading straight home!
10. **Remember, you are representing SONHC and as such we ask that you always be courteous and kind to everyone you encounter during our caravans and events!**

Directions

1. Depart the North bound Service Plaza traveling north on Rt93.

2. Continue on Rt93N and Take Exit 23 onto Rt105.

3. At the stop sign turn right onto Rt104 towards Meredith

4. Follow all the way until the light at the intersection of Rt106.

5. Turn left and follow into downtown Meredith along the lake.

6. Turn right at the light onto Winnipesaukee St. Rt25 and follow.

7. The Irving Station will be on the right.
