**ADOPT A STREET
GENERAL INFORMATION**

PROCESS

1. Contact the Adopt A Street coordinator (775-753-6295 opt 4) to confirm that the desired street segment is available for adoption. If unavailable, other locations will be offered. This must be done **prior** to completing the application and waiver form. The assigned location is entered on the application and waiver form.
2. Complete the application and waiver form on-line at:

 - By filling out the application you agree to the requirements and terms of the Adopt a Street Program.
3. Once the application is approved, the first clean-up can be scheduled. Signs will be installed after the first clean-up event has been held and will remain in place for the designated adoption period of two years.
4. Following each clean-up event, the contact person must notify the Adopt A Street Coordinator as to the date and location of the clean-up and if trash pick-up is required.

This program operates at the Spring Creek Associations discretion and may be discontinued at any time.

PURPOSE:

The Adopt A Street program enables community members, groups, clubs and or organizations, to actively participate in enhancing the overall appearance of The Spring Creek Association roads and community. Volunteers adopt one road in an SCA Tract and agree to remove trash/debris a minimum of four times per year for at least a two-year period.

WHO CAN ADOPT A STREET?

Any Spring Creek Association Resident, 18 years of age or older, who is willing to accept the responsibilities associated with the program and has the enthusiasm and dedication to make Spring Creek a better place to live can adopt a street. Examples include; individuals, businesses, community and civic organizations, neighborhood associations, and church groups.

WHAT STREETS CAN BE ADOPTED?

Any road within the SCA boundaries can be adopted with the completion of the application and waiver form, the applicant must communicate with the Adopt A Street Coordinator (775-753-6295 opt 4) to determine which street(s) are available. This information is entered on the application and waiver form.

WHAT IS REQUIRED OF VOLUNTEERS?

Volunteers commit to remove trash/debris along both sides of the adopted street for a two-year period. A minimum of four clean-ups per year are required (at least one every three months). Each person will be required to furnish and wear a safety vest and/or brightly colored clothing. Minors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or a responsible adult. Following each clean-up event, the contact person must notify the Adopt A Street coordinator as to the date and location of the clean-up and if trash pick-up is required. If quarterly clean-ups are not performed, the Adopt A Street signs will be removed and that street segment will be made available for others. Volunteers are encouraged to monitor conditions on their adopted street and report any problems to the Adopt A Street Coordinator.

WHEN CAN CLEAN-UPS OCCUR?

Clean-ups can occur during daylight hours only. A minimum of four clean-ups per year are required (at least one every three months).

WHERE CAN CLEAN-UPS OCCUR?

Clean-ups occur along both sides of the adopted street. No work will be permitted in the street. Traffic lanes are to be always kept open and unobstructed.

WHAT HAPPENS WITH THE CONTAINED TRASH?

Volunteers will collect trash/debris and leave in trash bags on the side of the road clear of traffic. Contained trash not removed by volunteers will be picked up by the SCA Road Crew. Place the contained bags and/or larger items in piles on the side of the road in the right of way next to the nearest street or stop sign, and notify the Adopt A Street Coordinator to schedule pick-up and the location of trash.

WHAT WILL THE SCA PROVIDE?

In recognition of the trash/debris removal efforts, SCA will fabricate and install signs crediting participants for their commitment to the program and community. The signs will be located at the beginning and end of the adopted street segment. If the adopted street is a cul-de-sac one sign will be installed at the start of the street.

Signs will be installed after the first clean-up event has been held and will remain in place for the designated adoption period of two years.

After the clean-up, the SCA will pick up the contained trash if needed.

WHAT LANGUAGE CAN BE PUT ON THE ADOPT A STREET SIGN?

There are four options for the language on the Adopt A Street sign:

- Option 1: The name of the entity.
- Option 2: The name of an individual.
- Option 3: The phrase "Friends of ...(name)".
- Option 4: The phrase "Family of ...(name)".

Only two lines of text are permitted with a maximum of fourteen characters per line.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER THE TWO YEAR COMMITMENT?

The agreement is in effect for a period of two years from the date the Adopt A Street application and waiver is approved. At the end of this period, participants may renew their adoption status by submitting another application and waiver form. If a new form is not submitted and approved, the signs will be removed and that street segment will be made available for others.
