

## **PSA - Spring Creek Association ATV/OHV**

1. Can a child without a license drive on the roads or the edges of the roads?
  - a. No. The operator of the ATV/OHV MUST possess a valid drivers license. This is the case for anyone who drives any vehicle on the public road.
2. Can I drive an ATV/OHV inside the Spring Creek Association amenities?
  - a. No. ATV/OHV are banned from operating on greenbelts, amenities, parks or any other private property owned by the SCA. This will be considered trespassing and further legal action will be taken. The exception is ATV/OHV's on the dirt roads at the SCA Campground and Shooting Range.
3. Can I operate my ATV/OHV during nighttime hours?
  - a. Operation of any ATV/OHV shall only occur between the hours of sunrise and sunset unless the operation of the ATV/OHV occurs in the non-residential areas of SCA. If the operation is after sundown, the vehicle must have legal lighting to permit nighttime use.
4. Are there restrictions on speed limits for ATV/OHV in residential areas?
  - a. Yes. A maximum speed limit for every ATV/OHV of 15 miles per hour when the vehicle is within 500 feet of any residential home or neighborhood which is majority of roads in Spring Creek, that distance being measured from the ATV/OHV to the rearrest point of the lot or parcel of such home or neighborhood. This applies to all ATV's, dirt bikes, dune buggy's, golf carts, OHV's, snowmobiles, etc.
  - b. Exclusion: Large all-terrain vehicles equipped and in compliance with all requirements of Nevada Revised Statutes 490.120 and legally registered in compliance with Nevada Revised Statutes 490.0825 may travel the posted speed limit on any road, highway, trail recognized and/or maintained and/or owned by Elko County and state highways as per Nevada Revised Statutes 490.110(d).
