

## Nature Art

Grade: Fourth



### Location(s):

Any outdoor area.

### Activity Length:

30-60 minutes

### Materials:

- Drawing Lessons
- Drawing paper
- Clipboards
- Pencils

### Preparation:

None

### Activity:

1. Have students sit in a circle. Discuss some of the natural objects in the area and how they might fit into the local ecosystem.
2. Ask each student to locate an object of nature, i.e. a leaf, pinecone, pine needle, etc.
3. Follow directions in one or both of the drawing lessons (links on the Take-It-Outside website) to practice drawing techniques.
4. Have students walk ten steps away from circle and find a new object.
5. Repeat exercise using the new object.
