CALIFORNIA SPICY CRAB STUFFED AVOCADO

### INGREDIENTS:

2 tablespoons light mayo  
2 teaspoons sriracha, plus more for drizzling  
1 teaspoon chopped fresh chives  
4 oz lump crab meat (or imitation)  
1/4 cup peeled and diced cucumber  
1 small avocado  
1/2 teaspoon sesame seeds  
2 teaspoons soy sauce

### DIRECTIONS:

In a medium bowl, combine mayo, sriracha and chives. Add crab meat and cucumber and chive and gently toss.

Cut the avocado open, remove pit and peel the skin or spoon the avocado out. Fill the avocado halves equally with crab salad. Top with sesame seeds and drizzle with soy sauce.

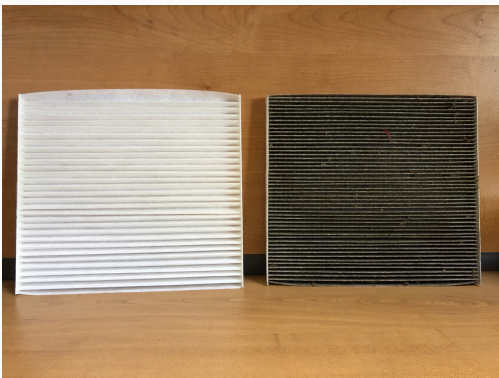
## Come in for our \$89 A/C Service and Filter Check

Did you know that the air conditioner in your car has an air filter just like the one in your house? The filter on the left is new and the filter on the right came out of a 2014 Sedona.

The filter catches the pollen, dust, leaves, bugs, and other debris as it comes through the heating, ventilation, and air conditioning system before we breathe it in. The owner's manual will tell you the if, where, when, and how to, but how often you should change your air filter really depends on your environment - if you drive through heavy traffic, during pollen season, or on dirt and gravel roads, you should change your filter more frequently.
