Keep children off the lawn until it has been watered and dried.

If possible, keep pets off until the grass has dried.

Do not mow lawn until it has been watered and is dry.

No weed control products have been applied. For best results and at your earliest convenience, please water until you have 4 to 6 inches (100 to 150 mm) of moist soil.

**Granular fertilizer does not need to be watered in.*

This application includes weed control products. Please wait 12 hours for these products to be absorbed and then water until you have 4 to 6 inches (100 to 150 mm) of moist soil. Deep watering is important because we can only control weeds that are actively growing. The weeds should die slowly over the next two weeks. Hardy weeds may require more than one application to control. Some of the weeds we treat such as Black Medic are prolific seed producers. In these cases we expect a new crop of weeds to emerge within four weeks after a treatment from seeds already in the soil. The newly emerged weeds will be treated at the next application, breaking the cycle of seed production. If one application is skipped then new weeds will produce new seeds and the cycle continues. It will take the full Guaranteed Green Program to gain control of these weeds.

Spring Green-Up Application. Fertilizer in April will give the lawn a great start. This application has all of the essential nutrients and plenty of slow release to help build the healthy roots needed when the stresses of summer heat arrive. Granular Liquid



Spring Weed Buster. Fertilizer in May and June will sustain the turf as it goes through its heaviest growth period of the season. Newly emerged weeds are treated at this time. Slow release nutrients will continue to build healthy roots.



Early Summer Weed Buster. Fertilizer in June and July will keep the turf vigorous as it is heading into the heat of summer. Weed controls are applied as needed to control stubborn weeds or those which are prolific seed producers.



Summer Maintainer. During July and August the cool season grasses growing in southern Alberta tend to go dormant. With adequate nutrition and irrigation they will maintain good color and tolerance to the stresses of this part of the season. It will be necessary to water longer at this time of the year.



Winterizer Fertilizer. Later in September and October it is very important to build up the energy reserves in the grass roots. This is the most important application of the year to have healthy stress resistant turf next season. Fall is also the best time to control stubborn perennial weeds such as dandelion and thistle. 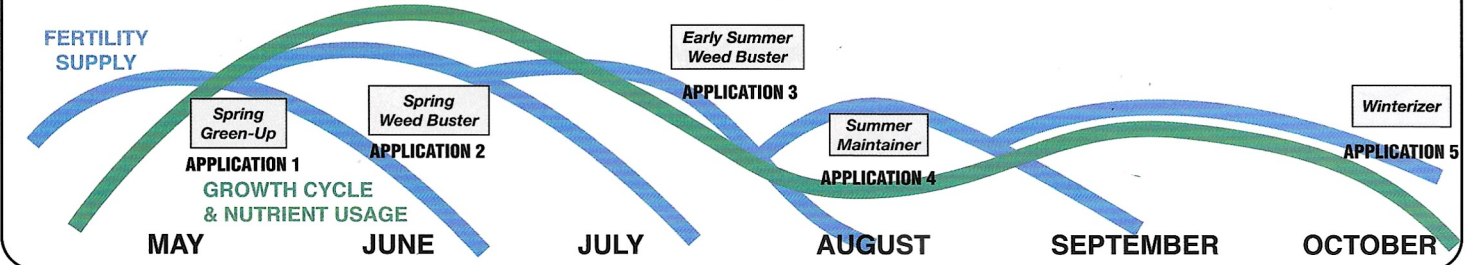

SPECIAL CONCERNS REGARDING YOUR LAWN

We will check the appropriate box if we notice a problem with your lawn.

- STRESS** from: lack of water; heat; insects; or disease. **REMEDY:** Water the lawn until you have 4 to 6 inches (100 to 150 mm) of moist soil. In extreme weather such as when the temperature is above 27° and/or when there is lots of wind, the lawn may need 1.5 inches (40 mm) of precipitation per week. The lawn may take about two weeks to recover completely if it has gone into dormancy. Deep watering once per week is still recommended but you will need to set the sprinklers to run longer at each cycle. This could take from one to four hours per spot depending on the type of sprinkler you are using. Probing the soil is the best way to know that you are getting water penetration to a depth of at least six inches.
- CUT TOO LOW.** **REMEDY:** Raise mower to a cutting height of 2.5 to 3.0 inches. Low cuts can put unnecessary stress on the grass and allows it to dry out too quickly. Closely mowed grass does not develop deep roots.
- PET DAMAGE** Pets can damage lawns by digging, running along the same path daily, chewing on the grass or by defecating and urinating on the grass. There is little we can do about any of these things short of removing the animal but we thought it would help you to know where these problems originate. **REMEDY:** If possible you may want to limit your pet's access to the lawn.
