

SPECIAL CONCERNS REGARDING YOUR LAWN

We will check the appropriate box if we notice a problem with your lawn.

STRESS from: lack of water; heat; insects; or disease. REMEDY: Water the lawn until you have 4 to 6 inches (100 to 150 mm) of moist soil. In extreme weather such as when the temperature is above 27° and/or when there is lots of wind, the lawn may need 1.5 inches (40 mm) of precipitation per week. The lawn may take about two weeks to recover completely if it has gone into dormancy. Deep watering once per week is still recommended but you will need to set the sprinklers to run longer at each cycle. This could take from one to four hours per spot depending on the type of sprinkler you are using. Probing the soil is the best way to know that you are getting water penetration to a depth of at least six inches.
CUT TOO LOW. REMEDY: Raise mower to a cutting height of 2.5 to 3.0 inches. Low cuts can put unnecessary stress on the grass and allows it to dry out too quickly. Closely mowed grass does not develop deep roots.
PET DAMAGE Pets can damage lawns by digging, running along the same path daily, chewing on the grass or by defecating and urinating on the grass. There is little we can do about any of these things short of removing the animal but we thought it would help you to know where these problems originate. REMEDY: If possible you may want to limit your pet's access to the lawn.
