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LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is a program provided through the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA) that assists eligible low-income households with their heating and cooling energy costs.

These programs are especially vital during the cold months of winter and during the hot summer months when the process of heating and cooling can place a huge strain on the family budget.

- Current photo ID for Head of Household and/or valid applicant
- Social Security cards for all household members
- Proof of income for entire previous calendar month for all Household members
- Current utility bill: power & gas

Additional Documents

For Section 8/HUD or income-based housing, a current copy of the utility allowance

Medical documentation for chronic diagnosis
