The MAIC was awarded \$127,000 to support its efforts in combating the opioid crisis in Mobile, AL, with a focus on assisting formerly incarcerated individuals struggling with opioid addiction.

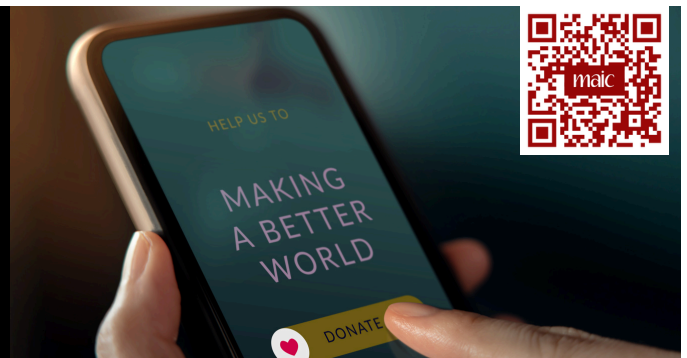


TEE TIME WITH TEAM CHAPLAINCY CHARITY GOLF TOURNAMENT
