BODY LANGUAGE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

This class was designed to provide law enforcement with a detailed understanding of non-verbal communication. Sean Grogan is also the first and currently only law enforcement officer in the United States that is a licensed Paul Ekman Associate.
