

UNMASKING HIDDEN FACIAL EXPRESSIONS

This class was designed to provide law enforcement with the tools to perform an aspect of policing that is severely lacking: recognizing facial expressions. Course content is based on science and the research of Dr. Paul Ekman. The course will teach officers how to recognize the 7 universal emotions found in micro-facial expressions and subtle facial expressions. Attendees will learn how to recognize facial expressions that flash on the face for only 1/25 to 1/2 second.

The instructor, Sean Grogan, is a police officer and canine handler in his 12th year in the state of New Jersey with almost 7 years experience as a narcotics detective. Sean Grogan is the first and currently the only law enforcement officer in the United States that is a licensed Paul Ekman Associate. This type of training can easily cost upwards of \$1,000.00 a day, however, Sean Grogan offers this training at a fraction of the cost to fellow law enforcement.

- Increase ability to recognize truthfulness
- Ability to articulate description of facial expressions for reports
 - Enhance communication with the public
