



SPECIALIZED TRAINING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

UNMASKING HIDDEN FACIAL EXPRESSIONS

This class was designed to provide law enforcement with the tools to perform an aspect of policing that is severely lacking: recognizing facial expressions. Course content is based on science and the research of Dr. Paul Ekman who has spent his life studying facial expressions and their relation to emotions and truthfulness. The course will teach officers how to recognize the 7 universal emotions found in micro-facial expressions and subtle facial expressions. Attendees will learn how to recognize facial expressions that flash on the face for only 1/25 to 1/2 second.

The instructor, Sean Grogan is a narcotics detective and canine handler in the state of New Jersey.

After studying facial expressions through self-study he traveled to Europe where he received extensive training on emotions, micro-facial expressions, subtle facial expressions, and how to recognize truthfulness. Sean Grogan is licensed through Paul Ekman International to provide periods of instruction on the knowledge he has gained regarding facial expressions. He is the first and currently the only law enforcement officer in the United States that is a licensed Paul Ekman Associate.

This type of training can easily cost upwards of **\$1,000.00** a day, however, Sean Grogan offers this training at a fraction of the cost to fellow law enforcement.

- Strengthen officer safety
- Upgrade ability to recognize truthfulness
- Ability to articulate descriptions of facial expressions for reports
- Enhance communication with the public
