Use the contraction don't with plural subjects, including I and you, too.

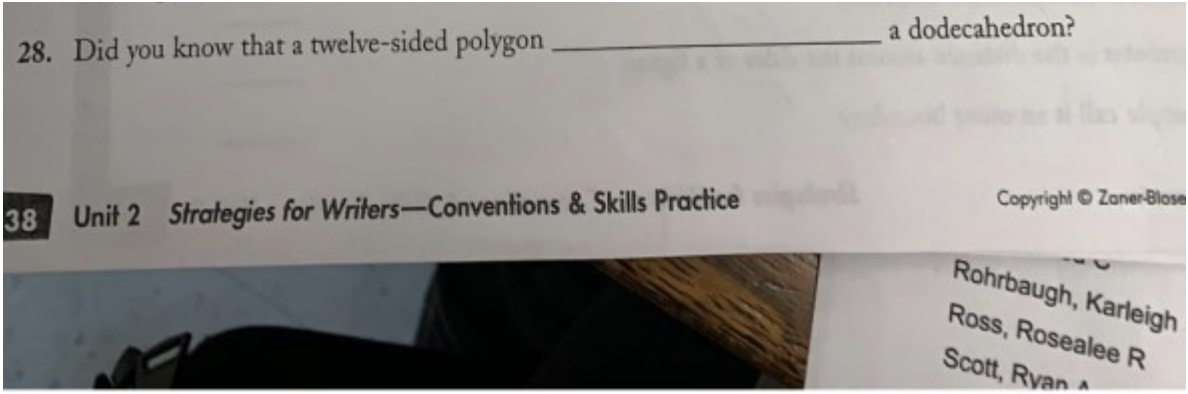
