

Supply list for TVEMS 6th graders for the 2020-21 School Year (Ms. Underwood and Mrs. Ward)

- 1) Plastic pencil box (the thin zippered pencil bag won't hold everything).
- 2) Several mechanical pencils in student's locker and at home. Each child should have 5 pencils in their pencil box each day.
- 3) Pack of colored pencils and a handheld sharpener to sharpen them.
- 4) A pair of scissors
- 5) 5-6 Glue sticks. Two of these should be in the pencil box each day.
- 6) 5-6 Single subject notebooks.
- 7) 2 Composition notebooks.
- 8) One three-prong, two-pocket folder (preferably plastic because it will last longer).
- 9) Several masks. Make sure your child has at least two at school each day in case something happens to one of them.
- 10) Water bottle (students will not be able to use the water fountain but will be able to use the filling station for the water bottles). Please put your child's name on the water bottle. Do not send juice, tea, Gatorade, etc. Water only.
- 11) Small cinch sack that will be put on the back of the student's chair to hold notebooks. The one your child received last year at the beginning of school is fine. If your child doesn't have it, please purchase an inexpensive one that will be left in the classroom.
- 12) Zippered binder or plastic accordion folder to transport papers to and from school.
- 13) Backpack to carry things to and from school.

Recommended by the county:

- 1) Individual size hand sanitizer (just for your child).
- 2) Lysol spray (or other brand) and wipes if somehow you can miraculously find either of these.
- 3) Put your child's name on pencils, pencil box, etc. because students cannot share supplies.
