AGREEMENT:

In order to be considered for the re-homing of a rescue Chihuahua advertised by the New Zealand Chihuahua Rescue Trust ("The Trust"), you, as the ("the Re-Homer") of a dog from the Former Owner hereby agree to the following:

- 1. The Re-homer is aware and accepts that the Trustees of the Trust have not met the dog concerned or assessed the dog and therefore cannot confirm suitability in terms of its social-ability with strangers, small animals and/or other dogs.
- 2. The Trust is not liable for any damage caused by allowing the dog into the Re-homer's home.
- **3.** Dogs are rehomed on an as is basis, we endeavour to disclose any health issues during advertising. However, we rely solely on the honesty of the former owner in doing so. The Trust is not responsible for any medical bills which shall arise for the dog received by the Re-homer.
- **4.** The Re-Homer will be responsible for the de-sexing of the dog, micro-chipping of the dog, flea and worming, dental and any other necessary medical treatment disclosed or required by the dog, if it has not already been completed.
- **5.** Any issues relating to the dog are to be directed to the former owner to resolve. The Trust accepts no liability or responsibility for any issues that arise.
- **6.** In the event that you are no longer able to care for the dog at any time. The Trust is to be notified immediately and the dog surrendered into the care of the Trust. For the absence of any doubt, the dog cannot be advertised or rehomed privately, under any circumstances.

Re-Homing Fee

7. The non-refundable rehoming fee of \$200.00 is to be paid to the Trust Account <u>prior</u> to the dog being received. The Trust does not accept cash on the day of changeover. The fee is to be paid into the account and not to the former owner. Failure to pay the fee will constitute a breach of this Agreement and the dog may be uplifted.

Breach of the Agreement

- **8.** In the event that the Re-Homer breaches any terms contained in this Agreement. The Trust reserves the right to immediately uplift the dog on behalf of the former owner. The Re-Homer confirms they will not obstruct removal or prevent the trust from uplifting the dog in any way. The Trust reserves the right to uplift a dog on behalf of the former owner should any concerns arise in relation to welfare, mistreatment, or abuse.
- **9.** By applying to the Trust, the Re-Homer confirms that all information supplied in the course of the adoption process is true and correct to the best of their knowledge and belief. The Re-Homer further confirms that they have been honest in all dealings with the Trust and informed the Trust of any information that may be relevant to their application.
- **10.** The Re-homer expressly acknowledges that re-homing a dog gives much less security than adopting from the Trust. The Re-homer acknowledges that the Trust is not liable for any medical or other costs in respect of the dog and any issues that arise in respect of the dog are to be directed to the former owner.
