

CHECKLIST – FOR DOGS GOING OUT ON TRIAL:

PROVIDE TO THE ADOPTER:

- Foster dogs' vet book – *please check you have their last flea/worming date in here.*
- CCC Council metal tag
- Adopter pack
- Bed/bedding
- Any toys provided by the trust the dog likes or toys that came with them
- Any items that came with the dog from their former home
- Medications for the dog that the dog is currently using, for example: heart medications (if no longer using – please return these to the Managing Trustee or the Vet)
- Vet specialist or raw food (if the dog is on either of these)
- Any clothing they like / use.
- Treats/chews.

CHECK:

- Has the Trust received the Trial Agreement from the Adopter?
- Has the Trust received the deposit for the Adoption Fee from the Adopter?

PLEASE **DO NOT** SEND WITH THE DOG:

- Metal crates, if provided by the trust (*Regular fosters can retain these at their homes if they wish*)
- Metal dog pens
- Travel crates, car clips or booster seats, if provided by the trust. (*Regular fosters can retain these at their homes if they wish*)
- Any bowls provided by the trust. (*Regular fosters can retain these at their homes if they wish*)
- Dog leads (they have a new one in their Adopter pack!) (*Regular fosters can retain these at their homes if they wish*)
- Grooming equipment (shampoos, clippers, brushes) (*Regular fosters can retain these at their homes if they wish*)
- Urine spray, puppy pads (*Regular fosters can retain these at their homes if they wish*)
- E-collars (medical Elizabeth collars)
- Large bags of food (we provide a small bag in the adopter pack and ask owners to ensure they have this prior to the trial beginning). (*Regular fosters can retain these at their homes if they wish*)
- Julius K9 harnesses owned by the trust + the personalized tags (we issue new ones each time based on the size of the foster dog).
- Spare medications (ie. Pain relief (Metacam) that can be used for other dogs)

NOTES:

- **What Do I Do With Trust Assets Now?** Once your foster dog is no longer in foster care, please contact the Trustees to organize a return of everything (aside from the above items that some regular fosters keep at their home). We will re-issue new assets to you once your next dog is in foster care.
