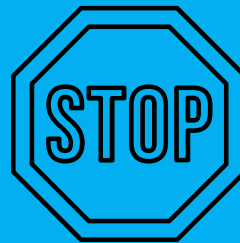

# Answer Key — Keep Your Family Safe!

## For Grown-Ups or Facilitators

### PAGE 3: MEDICINE SAFETY - WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

#### Statement Answer

- Take medicine that looks like candy
- Tell an adult if you find a pill on the floor
- Keep medicine locked in a cabinet
- Share medicine with your friend

**Extra Guidance:** Emphasize that all medicine should only be taken with adult supervision, and even vitamins can be harmful if taken without permission.

### PAGE 4: CIRCLE THE ITEMS THAT ARE SAFE TO TOUCH WITHOUT ASKING:

Safe	Not Safe (Do not be touched without an adult):
Soap	Juice (Could be confused with cleaning product)
Candy	Bleach Bottle
Pizza	Bug Spray
Toys	Vitamins
Apple	Milk (Depends, but talk about checking first)
