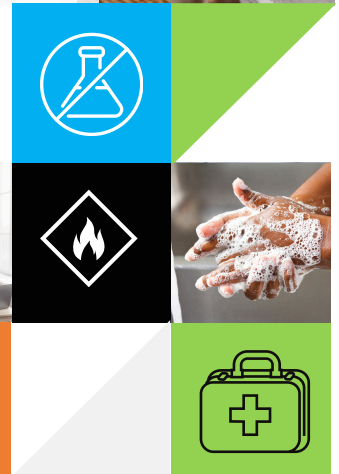

## Make Your **Home Safe!**

### MEDICATION SAFETY

- Find all medicines in your home – are they in original containers?
- Store them up high and out of reach of kids & pets.
- Dispose of expired or unused medications at approved drop-off sites.

### HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL SAFETY

- Lock up cleaning supplies and dangerous products.
- Make sure every container has a clear, readable label.
- Follow safety directions to the letter.

### CHEMICAL DISPOSAL

- Never dump chemicals in sinks, toilets, or trash bins.
- Transport chemicals in sealed, original containers.
